ERROR COMÚN EN WRITING: **HASN'T** (sin e). En inglés los signos de admiración (!) y de interrogación (?) solo se escriben al final de la oración. En las preguntas con *have got* y *has got* el sujeto va en medio: *Have you got?* *Has she got?*

Trace /treɪs/:

Have you got?

Has she got?

I have got.

He has got.

We haven't got.

It hasn't got.

- I have got a pencil. I haven't got it.
- You have got a pencil. You haven't got it.
- She has got a rubber. She hasn't got it.
- Have you got a marker? Yes, I have got it.

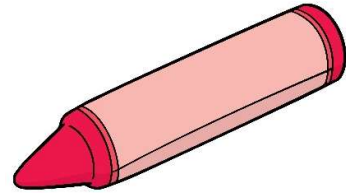
